<b>Other Info:</b>	Wyebrook Estate is a small vineyard on the edge of town in Blenheim, in the renowned wine region of Marlborough, New Zealand. Cook Strait (M ori: Te Moana-o-Raukawa), is named after Captain James Cook the

first European commander to sail through it in 1770, lies between the North and South Islands of New Zealand. Wyebrook's philosophy is to grow fresh wine, with minimal interference with nature - both in the vineyard and the winery, although they are not officially classed as an organic producer. Wyebrook Estate is a small vineyard owned and managed by long-time Marlburians and winegrowers, Steve and Steph Fisher who also run a vineyard management service and a winery maintenance supply centre.
