The Viñedo Chadwick vineyard is located in Puente Alto, on the south-east border of Santiago, the capital of Chile, along the Northern bank of the Maipo River in the foothills of the Andes Mountains. The aim is to make an elegant wine showing the Maipo Valley at its highest level with soft tannins, berry fruit characteristics on the nose and palate with an added dimension of power and intensity in the finish.
