Description: This Blanc de Blancs is made from the highest quality 'cuvee' juice pressed from selected hand-picked Chardonnay grapes grown at Albourne Estate. As a wine of a single vineyard and single vintage it reflects the nuances of place and weather patterns so creating a true 'terroir' wine.

The Albury Blanc de Blancs is a blend of 53% Chardonnay with 47% Seyval Blanc with its signature stamp of aromatic fruit and floral hints on the nose. The palate on this is light, fresh and very English. The flavour has this 'freshly picked green apple from an English orchard' character, which is really appropriate.
