Château Fayau is located in picturesque old market town of Cadillac, on the right bank of the Garonne river some 30 km upstream from Bordeaux. The Fayau vineyards are on the 1er Côtes, just outside the town of Cadillac, with mainly southwest facing slopes, and a number of south-facing plots reserved for the sweet Cadillac wines. The 85 acre estate has been in the Medeville family since 1826 who carry on the proud tradition of making sweet botrytised wines and a traditional red Bordeaux blend.
