Other Info: Guy and Cédric Allion of Domaine du Haut Perron have 23 hectares of vines on the wonderfully exposed slopes of the Cher's right bank in the Loire Touraine Appellation. The soils here are clay and limestone embedded with flint which is known as 'Perruches' in the area. These flint deposits give their wines their trademark crisp minerality.

The Domaine practice a sustainable viticulture, looking to the long-term

wellbeing of their terroir. They use traditional techniques and organic fertilisers alongside careful observation of the vines to ensure healthy and good quality grapes are produced.
