This means meticulous vineyard management to grow the best grapes, rigorous fruit selection and delicate nurture through fermentation and maturation. The beautiful Maremma, where the vineyard is situated, has become one of Italy's most important wine regions. The climate here is Mediterranean with hot summers (moderated by nightly sea breezes)



long autumns, mild humid winters and rainy springs. It is warmer and milder than in the heart of Tuscany, allowing the grapes to ripen much more easily than in some other regions. Bonifcaio make wines in the style of Sassicaia and Tignanello, and whilst the quality is comparable, prices are considerably lower!
