Food / cocktail match: Cabernet Franc makes an excellent match for cured meats and pates, particularly those which, like the wine, have a slightly herbal edge to them.

Food / cocktail recipe:

Press 'Bright purple, with crunchy blueberry fruit, Iodine and iris. It has a decent structure which carries the fruit rather than dominates; youthful tannins but well integrated. Delicious.' - The Buyer

Domaine Gayda is situated south East of Carcassonne in the Languedoc region of South West France, an area known traditionally for its large area of vineyards producing mainly table wines.
