Emilio Lustau was established in 1896 and was initially a small family concern until the founder's son-in-law placed it on a business footing. The firm is perhaps best known as pioneering the Almacenista system, whereby individual dry sherries are produced from small private holdings. These are bottled under Lustau's name but with the individual bodega's name on the label as well. Today they are amongst the most sought after Sherries in the region.
