Other Info:	Originally (1689) celebrated as a festive wine, today pineau is often categorised as an aperitif. However limiting it to an aperitif is to underestimate the complexity it conceals; together with friends discover the many facets of a Chateau de Beaulon pineau.

Beaulon Pineaux des Charentes are easily distinguishable due to their complex fruitiness from Bordeaux grape varieties : Semillon/Sauvignon

for the white ; Cabernets Franc/Sauvignon and Merlot for the red.
Together with the aromas of old cognac and oak ageing the result is a
delicious harmony of 5 grape varieties.

Serve them at your table with the most refined dishes and the 'Vieilles
Reserves' will add another delectable dimension. Served in the
appropriate glass it will enhance the natural shimmer of their robe and
the delights of their complex aromas.
