'French wine-maker Maison Louis Jadot chose Oregon for its first venture outside France since the company was formed in 1859. Its debut release, a single vineyard bottling, comes from the Yamhill-Carlton region, 40 miles east of the Pacific Ocean, with its ancient, marine-

sediment enriched soil. It's complex and rich with layered flavours of plum, coffee and soft fruits, with a long but surprisingly dry finish. It can be drunk now, but it will become even more interesting if kept for a few more years.' - John Clarke, The Independent]

Other Info:

Well known Burgundian producer Louis Jadot acquired the vineyard in 2013, but the whole style of the wine is very different from the Oregon norm, being much more Burgundian in style. The man behind it is Jadot's much-admired winemaker of 40 years, Jacques Lardière who, since officially retiring from the company's cellars on the outskirts of Beaune, has been based in Oregon.
