**Other Info:** Tormore Distillery was founded in 1958, and was the first new distillery to be built in Speyside during the 20th century. Tormore was intended to be a 'showpiece', the distillery has crisp white buildings with ornate features, a fountain and curling lake and decorative landscaping. In the 1970s the numbers of stills was increased from four to eight
